Eligibility Criteria

Program: Bachelor of Engineering or Bachelor of Computer Science **with at least twenty credits** completed.

Status: Full-time enrollment Fall 2009 and Winter 2010

GPA: Last Annual Grade Point Average of 2.00 or higher

Citizenship: Open to Canadian Citizens, Permanent Residents, and International Students

Value: \$1,000.00

Applicant's Essay

Qualified students who wish to be considered for this award must, in addition to their application form, submit a 500-word essay which details their involvement in student life activities, and participation in student associations, within the Faculty of Engineering and Computer Science.

Essays will be judged on content, as well as the quality of the applicant's reasoning and written expression of ideas. Submissions will be considered by the Faculty of Engineering and Computer Science in October 2009.
