# **Instructional Technology Award**

The Instructional Technology Award is intended to encourage and reward students and teams of students currently enrolled in the final year of a Software Engineering or Computer Science undergraduate program at Concordia University undertaking Capstone or similar term projects in the area of e-learning technology, tools and techniques, preferably as applied to engineering and computer science education and whose commitment and spirit towards multi-media instructional technology, reflect the values exemplified by the best practices of Educational Technology.

Candidates for this award may be Canadian Citizens, Permanent Residents, or International Students. The award will be granted through competition to a team of full-time students in Software Engineering or Computer Science. All candidates must have a GPA of at least 2.00.

The criteria for the best project will include the following, but will not be limited to:

- Originality of project concept
- Innovation in implementation
- Incorporation of best practises in instructional technology

Submissions for this award will be adjudicated by committee in the Faculty of Engineering and Computer Science and the recipient will be selected in May 2010.
