ABSTRACT

Dr. Yue Lu is a professor of the Department of Computer Science and Technology, East China Normal University. He is currently a visiting scientist at CENPARMI, Concordia University. Dr. Lu received both his Bachelor and Master's degrees from Zhejiang University, and his Ph.D. from Shanghai Jiao Tong University. From 1993 to 2000, he was an engineer at the Third Research Institute of Posts and Telecommunications Ministry of China. Before he joined East China Normal University in 2004, he was a research fellow with the Department of Computer Science, National University of Singapore. His research interests include document image analysis and retrieval, natural language processing, biometrics, and intelligent system development. Acting as the project leader of developing automatic letter sorting machines for China Post, his recent research focuses on applications of document image recognition to postal automation. Because of his outstanding contributions to the research and development of automatic mail sorting systems, he won the Science and Technology Progress Award issued by the Ministry of Posts and Telecommunications in 1995, 1997 and 1998, the Science and Technology Award issued by China Post in 2007, and was nominated as a specialist who enjoys the special government allowance granted by the State Council of China in 2010.
